Director Martinez discussed incoming funds relating to property tax, ditch billing, member agency payments, and monitoring costs. He suggested to stop spraying because of the rain and suggested to prepare a bid for the spraying to insure the District is paying the best price.

The Board directed staff to get a cost estimate to prepare a rate study for ditch fees and asked for a report within 6 to 9 months.

10. Old Business

a. Office Lease – Receive report and provide direction to staff regarding options for leased office space.

Mr. Currey noted that NRCS is finalizing their arrangements for their move and they are expecting Dixon RCD's decision in January. He discussed meeting with the property owner's representative for the current location and they proposed a flat fee of \$1.25 per square foot. He discussed the expenses with moving to Vacaville would be \$1.75 per square foot and a separate meter. He noted all spaces are calculated differently.

Director Martinez leaned toward staying in Dixon, but noted a comment from a Farm Service Agency employee about what a help Mr. Currey is to them. Director Martinez thought that may be taken into consideration.

Mr. Currey noted options will be scheduled for the next Board meeting agenda and Solano RCD will be discussing near the same time.

11. New Business

a. Personnel Committee – Receive report and provide direction to staff and the Personnel Committee regarding staffing levels and wages for Fiscal Year 2015-2016.

Mr. Currey discussed staff allocations, 2015 Dixon RCD and Solano RCD staff budget hours, and total hours by project. He discussed the time spent working with the Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area (YBWA) may not be the best use of resources. He told the YBWA Manager and Yolo RCD that the Dixon RCD Board may agree, in which case transition could start in February 2015. He felt YBWA and Yolo RCD could be a good partnership and work on projects together.

Mr. Currey discussed possibly hiring a data management employee in 2016, the initial costs and hours and reallocation of resources for irrigated lands. He noted the data captured will be more important for landowner compliance and more critical for the Coalition.

Director Martinez expressed concern with the costs and hours associated with the District Engineer and if the position could help with irrigated lands at a lesser rate.

Mr. Currey stated the majority of the District Engineer's time in 2016 will be related to the Joint Powers Authorities (JPA). The time for both JPAs is more than he anticipated.

Mr. Campbell thought whether the time is worth more than \$10,000 should be considered.
