#### 9. New Business

a. Receive staff update regarding survey responses to spoils management landowner survey. (ACTION)

Mrs. Huff gave an overview of the survey that we sent out, expressing that as of today we have only received about 40% response. So Mrs. Huff asked the Board how they want her to proceed. Accept this or continue to reach out with the understanding that we are trying to achieve 100% participation in order to be able to develop a plan to move towards a solution that works for everyone.

The Board collectively agreed that we should continue to reach out. The more people that we can get to participate the better understanding of where we sit as a district.

Then Mrs. Huff asked if the board wanted her to present options at the next board meeting or should the Ditch committee met about it first and formulate a tentative plan to present to the Board.

A motion was made by Director Viguie, seconded by Director Bei, to continue to reach out to as many ditch adjacent landowners as we can reach; along with agreeing that the Ditch Committee should first review the survey results then report back to the board. The motion passed as follows:

b. JPA Regional Drainage Update – Receive JPA committee member and staff report on 01-27-21 JPA Meeting and provide direction regarding further Dixon RCD input (ACTION)

Mrs. Huff gave a summary report on the latest Dixon Regional Watershed JPA meeting where the Northeast Quadrant Detention

Basin pre-design evaluation was accepted as the preferred project. Solano County submitted another comment letter reiterating their concerns.

Director Bei reported that he and Mrs. Huff took an engineer from Wood Rogers for a tour of the entire Tremont 3 system. Wood Rogers is conducting work for the related SCWA funded project to update the Dixon Watershed Management Plan. Director Bei went on give a brief update on the 01/27/21 JPA meeting, stating that it seems as though there is a disconnect between the county and our JPA agencies, the ultimate goal does not appear to be the same. There is a perception that the objective of the county is primarily financial, where the perception of the JPA is that this project would provide immediate and long term solutions for the region.

Director Viguie brought up that it has been recommended that DRCD appoint an alternate to the JPA board in addition to the already appointed representatives, to allow for voting if and when any potential conflicts of interests were to be encountered in regards to the NEQ Project. Director Viguie then went on to bring up a separate discussion point for future DRCD board consideration. He suggested that DRCD may want to re-evaluate our part in this project and the JPA. Director Viguie stated that after many years of this proposed project, he is not entirely sure why we are involved to the extent that we currently are. He then asked the board to please think about our role and what it should be and could we as a board revisit this discussion at a later date. He went on to say that he believes the project should continue forward, he is just not confident that DRCD should be driving it. Adding a thought point of "What is the benefit to the District"?

Director Bei agreed that the project should move forward, and that the alternatives that the county is suggesting, would simply not be accepted by the majority of the farming community, specifically the proposal that farmers will accept "flooding easements".

Director Beukelman posed the question, "Do we have an option to pull out of the JPA altogether and/or this particular project"?

Mrs. Huff stated that we can maintain an open invitation to discuss and think about the direction of DRCD's role within the DRWJPA in future DRCD meetings.

Both Director Jones and Director Schene offered to join the JPA Board as an alternate. Ultimately Director Schene agreed to be the alternate.

A motion was made by Director Viguie, seconded by Director Bei, to appoint Director Schene as the alternate on the Dixon Regional Watershed Joint Powers Authority Board as a DRCD representative. The motion passed as follows:
