 - a. Final 2019 / 2020 Dixon RCD Budget Report Receive Staff Report (NO ACTION / Director's Prep)

Mrs. Huff reviewed the current ending cash position of the Dixon RCD Budget. She reviewed the revenues and expenditures of the district's operations. The Board members made general comments in reference to Mrs. Huff's statements. Director Viguie said his concern was with the negative \$6,000 net position in groundwater. Mrs. Huff explained that this was due to the unreimbursed staff time participating in the groundwater management agency. Director Viguie responded that with grants maybe it could mirror these costs.

b. 2020 Outstanding Ditch Maintenance Fees and Annual Parcel Assessment – Review and consider outstanding Ditch Maintenance Fee accounts for possible adjustments – (ACTION / Director's Prep) Mrs. Huff reviewed the outstanding Ditch fees accounts and the interest owed and whether or not the Board would like to waive the fees. There was a general discussion from the Board that it was not worth the staff time to continue to pursue the interest owed in these accounts.

"Virtual Tour" of the Dixon RCD Ditch System – Receive staff presentation and provide input – (NO ACTION / Director's Prep) Mrs. Huff shared the new program that she has been working on with Kevin Young-Lai that maps all of the culverts within the Drainage system of the Dixon RCD Ditches. The virtual tour showed the Board members photos of the culverts and allowed for conversation about maintenance strategies.

Director Bei suggested adding to the map facilities on the ditches and the names of the landowners that have maintenance responsibilities on portions of the Ditch. For example dams on Lateral 3 and who take care of that area of the Ditch? Director Viguie suggested adding these facilities during the next irrigation season.

 d. Solano Sub basin Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) – Review of Technical Memo 1 Surface Water System Water Budget – (NO ACTION / Director's Prep)

Mrs. Huff gave an overview of the General Plan. The Freshwater Trust and Luhdorff and Scalminini will be receiving a grant from DWR to look for potential groundwater re-charge opportunities in the Solano Sub basin and they will start with the Dixon area.
