 - CalPERS State Social Security Administrator Receive staff report regarding the District's existing Section 218 Agreement and consider authorizing payment of the new annual CalPERS Fee

Mr. Currey explained that going forward we will have a fee payment due every September to the SSSA CalPERS. This is a newly implemented fee this year 2019. The annual fee will be \$200, in addition we received a notice of a penalty fee of an additional

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\$100. Mr. Currey does not feel that we should have to pay a fine for an invoice we never received. He is recommending the Board authorize payment of the \$200 for sure and the possibly the \$100 fine, however we will do everything we can to avoid having to pay that \$100.

Mr. Currey believes that if a local government agency chooses to participate in the Social Security System it must have the Section 218 agreement and now pay the annual fee to SSSA CalPERS.
