6. New Business

a. DRCD 2020-2021 Ditch Maintenance – Review current practices, feedback from ditch members regarding maintenance, consider plans for remainder of 2020-2021 and future years. Provide direction and recommendations to the Board. (Action)

Ms. Huff presented the current status of 2020-2021 maintenance activities & costs as well as recent concerns expressed by ditch members regarding spoils management. The 2016 rate study and the annual maintenance budgeting assume that the majority of spoils management would continue to be performed by landowners or tenants. Ms. Huff has had three ditch members express concern about the costs and impacts of spoils management, in some cases expressing the expectation that all spoils would be hauled off after ditch cleaning.

Directors Bei and Beukelman expressed concern over the increases in per mile excavation costs over the last several years and the potential for additional exponential increases in maintenance costs if the District plans to haul spoils away. As an example, Director Bei estimated that the removal costs of the spoils from the recent excavation on Lateral 1A would be around \$10,000 for ½ mile. Ms. Huff explained Dixon RCD is due to conduct a new request for proposals (RFP) for ditch maintenance services in 2021. The current on call service agreement is based on an hourly rate. The new RFP could be structured to request estimates based on amount of material estimates and/or distances.

Director Beukelman requested that Ms. Huff provide estimates of the amount of spoils material that currently exists within the system that would need to be moved to address the impacts to all ditch members. Ms. Huff explained that the costs to conduct the 2016 rate study were \$50,000 over three years.

Director Bei suggested that we encourage landowners to incorporate spoils when transitioning to orchards or drip irrigation.

Director Beukelman and Director Bei recommended that the ditch committee reconvene after the policy committee meets to provide recommendations to the full board at their January 13th meeting.
