DRCD 2022-2023 Ditch Maintenance – Review planned maintenance activities for remainder of 2022-2023 (Action) –

The Committee Members reviewed the maintenance plans for 2022-2023 and offered the following recommendations for the District Manager.

- **Review excavation plans**

2022-2023 Adjusted Plan: This fall/winter/spring, weather dependent, have Mike Kett excavate Tremont 2 (main stem from Sikes to Bulkley, Laterals A, B, C and Maxwell).

Have Yolo Flood Control and Water Conservation District clean Lateral 1 from Jang Shop to Atkinson's driveway this fall/winter, weather permitting.

Move the planned stretches on Silvey Joy and Lateral 2 / South Cross Drain to 2023-2024.

- **Review herbicide application plans**

Kelly reported that Phil Washburn was scheduled to conduct a system wide winter spray between December 1-15th of Payload (Flumioxazin pre-emergent) and Cornerstone Plus (Glyphosate). We can go with a higher concentration for \$10-\$20 more per acre (\$2,000 more total). Director Bei recommended that we have Phil spray at the higher concentration and soon.

- **Ditch Repair & Debris Removal & Spoil Leveling**

Kelly reviewed additional sites that are in need of debris removal and ditch repairs and spoil leveling (see map).

- **Culvert Replacements**

The committee members recommended replacing the culvert with damaged inlet/outlet at Maxwell/Tremont 2 during the cleaning of that system.
