7. Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Report -

Ms. Teri Knight provided a written report this month. NRCS currently has 22 applications based on the November 3rd cut off. More applications were received after that and staff are working on planning for the possible selection for funding. See NRCS's Report for more details.

8. Old Business -

a. Encroachment Permit – Consider encroachment permit application for 6734 Midway Rd Auto Storage Facility Project (ACTION)

Consideration of this encroachment permit was brought back to December's board meeting to gather more information on historical issues with contaminants in the project area and potential risks to Dixon RCD's facilities and downstream landowners. She reached out to Solano County Resource Management staff who referred her to the State Geotracker website includes information on the cleanup and closing of the sites as well as two comfort letters from the Regional Water Quality Control Board regarding the review of the current project design. With this information Ms. Huff felt comfortable with the contaminant issues being addressed properly. The landowners in attendance of this meeting explained their concerns on what is the guarantee that the problem won't show up years from now and they and neighboring landowners won't be to blame. The board heard their concerns and in consensus came up with conditions to add to the encroachment to require a flow measuring weir, to notify Dixon RCD and to test water quality in the event of a discharge. If these conditions are accepted the board is in agreement to approve the encroachment permit.

Ms. Huff gave an update on regional drainage activities since our November meeting. SCWA and Solano County are looking for ways to address the concerns from JPA's October meeting, another draft Tech

Memo from West Yost, for the City specific drainage projects, is being reviewed which should be available to each entity to review before the next JPA meeting. Ms. Huff, with MBK Engineers, is in the process of reviewing the Dixon Innovation Center Proposed Project to change zoning and change the City's Northeast Quadrant Specific Plan with comments due by December 22nd. Lastly, a minor amendment is being requested to the JPA agreement. Both Maine Prairie and Reclamation District 2068 asked if they could make staff eligible to serve on the board. Legal counsel was informed and said yes, but an amendment will have to come to each entity's board and need to be approved before going to the JPA. A more formal request should come sometime in January.
