 Ditch Maintenance Fees – Receive report regarding the type and nature of Ditch Maintenance Fee and provide direction to staff regarding future fee adjustments.

Mr. Currey reported the new legal counsel was hired and was asked to review ditch fees, discussed the Prop 218 process, general election voting process and landowner voting process, and suggested doing the study in case a rate change is necessary. He also discussed the active effort to define stormwater to be equivalent to waste water, water and solid waste for the purpose of Prop 218 rate adjustment. If this effort is successful then the process of changing the rate would end at the protest vote.

Mr. Soukeris asked if income is enough to cover the costs.

Director Martinez responded that for the last 11 years, the Yolo Bypass has basically covered the shortfall in ditch fees. As in the previous Yolo Bypass discussion and action, those funds are ending this fiscal year. Director Martinez preferred a basic study at minimal cost and felt it would provide the necessary information.

Mr. Currey noted the rate study would confirm assumptions for a rate increase, discussed the next steps, thought a low cost study may be sufficient, and made the District Directors aware that they will need to educate the payers about the rate increase.

Mr. Soukeris thought that as long as the District seeks input, that the increase should be understood, but felt currently many do not understand.

a. District Manager's Report

Mr. Currey reviewed his written report and the discussed the following:

- Director Martinez discussed the Campbell Soup and tenant dispute, thought there should not be waste water in ditch, and Campbell Soup should be responsible for infrastructure that they previously installed;
- The District is working with Mr. Malitz who wants to revitalize his property.
 The District will be improving our ditch maintenance road on his property,
 including three field drains to replace cuts in the access road previously
 created by the District;
