a. Budget Review – Receive staff report on the final 2014 / 2015 Fiscal Year Budget.

Mr. Currey highlighted items from the report relating to Ditch Operations and District Operations that he plans to include in the upcoming newsletter. He will be asking the Board for input on the newsletter at the next meeting.

b. Sustainable Ground Water Management Act (SGMA) – Receive staff report on the Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) formation process and consider the proposed principles and board members.

Mr. Currey discussed the formation of the Solano Subbasin Joint Powers Authority of 16 members. He noted that until SGMA, Solano Irrigation District and Reclamation District 2068 had conjunctive use plans. He plans to continue to represent the district, and noted the structure of future fees is one of the current issues that the formation committee is working on. He also discussed the proposed process to choose the two public members.

c. District Planning – Consider key priorities and goals for programs and operations in preparation to update the District's Long Range Plan.

Mr. Currey asked the Board to consider what they want as priorities and noted that he is actively discussing with two individuals to become Dixon RCD Board members.

Director Holdener suggested contacting some local Pest Control Advisors (PCA) to be on the Board.

Director Martinez preferred being informal and flexible with focus on the list, felt landowner's values should be considered, and felt this Board has been doing the most to implement the long range plan.

Director Viguie thought the priorities are ditch, water quality, sustainable groundwater, and possibly area wide drainage. He preferred percentages on this list.

Mr. Currey felt focus on basic services is being achieved. He would like to revisit this in January and present a draft in March or April.
