

# Trade Names for Oxyflourfen and Imidacloprid

## Oxyfluorfen:

### Commonly Used Agricultural Trade Names:

**Goal® 2XL:** Often considered the industry standard (Nufarm).

**GoalTender®:**

**Galigan®:** Widely used formulation (ADAMA).

**OxyStar®:** A popular generic alternative

**Willowood OxyFlo 2EC/4SC**

**Oxyfluorfen 2E**

**Rout®** (granular, usually mixed with oryzalin)

**OH2®** (Ornamental Herbicide II) (mixed with pendimethalin)

## Imidacloprid:

### Commonly Used Agricultural Trade Names:

**Admire® Pro / Admire® 2 Flowable:** Systemic soil/foliar insecticide.

**Gaucho®:** Commonly used as a seed treatment.

**Confidor®:** Frequently used on crops for sucking insects.

**Merit®:** Often used on turf and ornamental plants.

**Provado®:** Used for foliar application on crops.

**Alias® / Alias® 2F:** Used as a systemic insecticide.

**Nuprid® / Pasada® / Prey®:** Generic alternatives often used in agriculture.

**Couraze® / Macho®:** Other common agricultural formulations.

**Imidastar / Imicide:** Used for various pests in agricultural settings.
